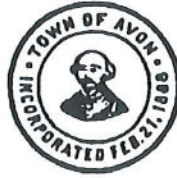

To: Board of Selectmen, Town Staff and Residents of Avon:

It is with a mix of emotions that I hereby submit my resignation as Town Administrator. The effective date will be January 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2023. For four and a half years, it has been my honor to serve the Board of Selectmen and people of Avon. I am grateful for the opportunity and trust I was given to serve this great town. It is an amazing community with many great qualities and opportunities in the future.

We have achieved many things over this time including completing two major public building projects, four balanced budgets with no layoffs during COVID-19, with an increase to staffing in both police and fire. We went from \$5,000 in excess levy capacity to approximately \$1.7 million in excess capacity (approx. 3.6 million if including debt exclusions). We worked to create fiscal policies, a five-year capital improvement plan and other policies to improve fiscal transparency. These tasks allowed us to increase the bond rating to AA+ from S&P, saving the town thousands of dollars. There are many more projects in progress or planned that will serve the community for decades to come.

This has only been possible through the support of the community and the phenomenal town staff with whom it has been a privilege to work alongside. The hardworking employees ensure that the town's services and operations have been carried out during an unimaginable pandemic. It has been an honor to get to know, observe their dedication, and work together to make Avon a better community.

I feel assured that the Selectmen and the department staff will continue to provide the leadership and guidance that has been essential to advancing the improvements to our Town.

I care deeply about Avon and am committed to work supportively in this transition to position the community and the organization for future success. It has been my pleasure to work with each of you, our employees and the residents Avon. I wish everyone the very best.
