



The Andover Police Department, in conjunction with Greater Lawrence Family Health Center, will be hosting a public “overdose education” training on Wednesday, August 26th, from 6-8 pm. The training is free and open to the public, but registration will be required. The training is being conducted by members of the Greater Lawrence Family Health Center; members of the Andover Police Department will be on hand to answer any questions.

The program will focus on helping family and friends recognize the signs and symptoms of addiction, how to prevent an overdose and what to do if one occurs. The training covers the importance of calling 9-1-1, how to perform rescue breathing and how to administer NARCAN (naloxone) intra-nasally.
